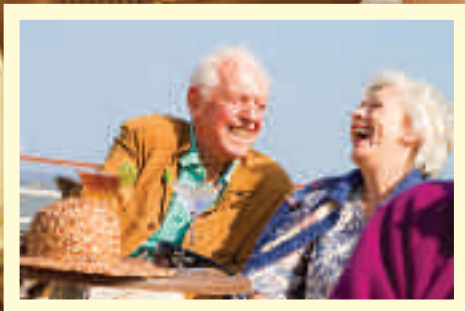
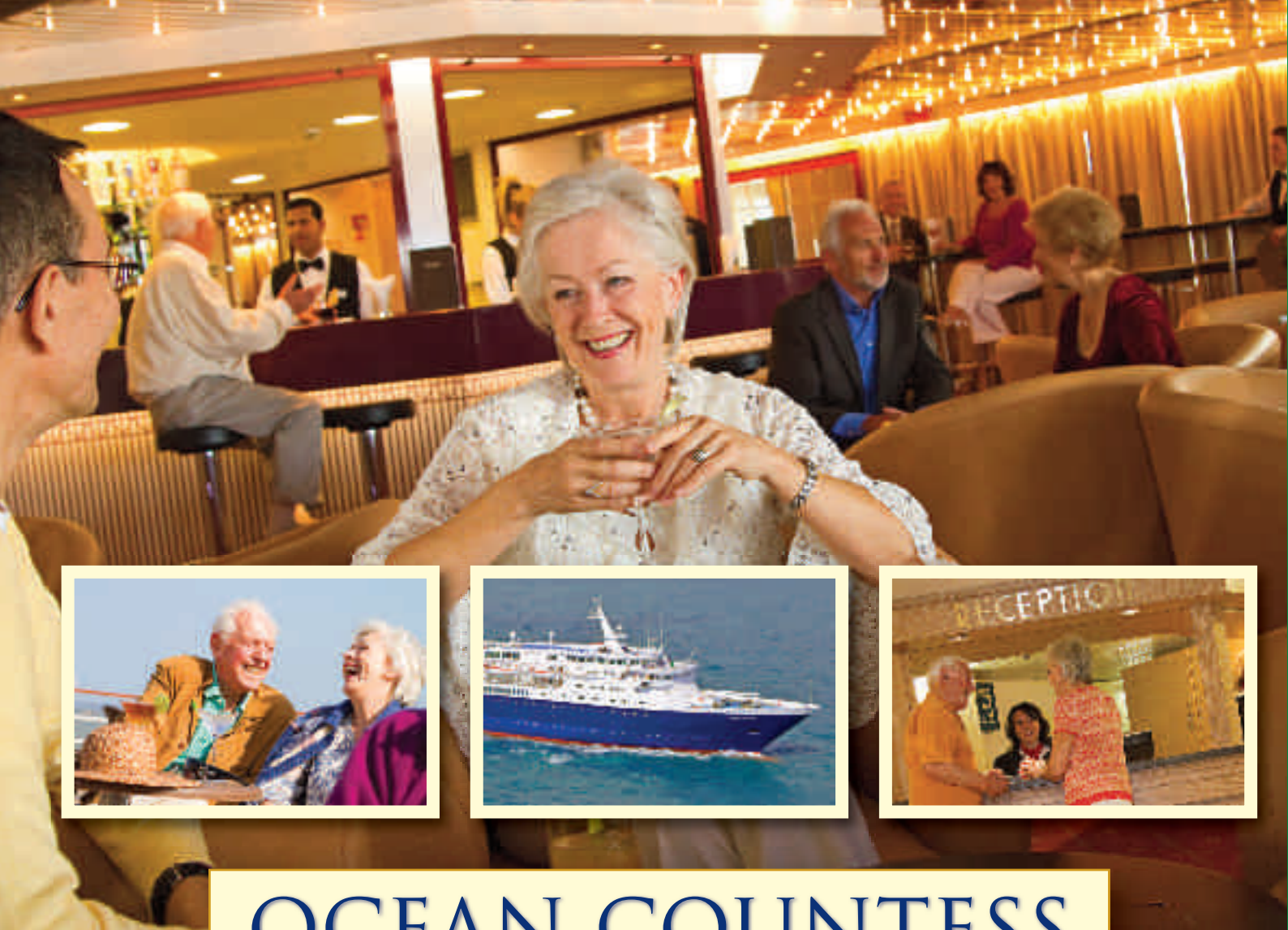

AUTUMN ON THE IBERIAN COASTLINE

RELAX IN comfortable surroundings on board *Ocean Countess* as you sail to the warmth of Spain, Portugal, and Morocco, calling in at Gibraltar on the way. This cruise of contrasts combines fascinating cities, a wealth of maritime history and the opportunity to explore ancient streets, castles and palaces. Discover the picturesque Algarve coast, indulge in some retail therapy, or just relax and watch the world go by on this great value autumn escape.

From Dublin, enjoy two relaxing days at sea before arriving at **Lisbon**, the Portuguese capital, with its many unique sights including the atmospheric lanes of the medieval Alfama district, the magnificent Monastery of St. Jerónimos and the Castelo de São Jorge (Saint George's Castle) with its panoramic views. The next day is spent in contrasting **Praia da Rocha**, a popular resort on the Algarve with vast sandy beaches, rocky outcrops and sandstone cliffs. As well as offering duty-free shopping, **Gibraltar's** military heritage is just waiting to be explored. Visit Europa Point, home to the famous Barbary apes, or ride to the top of the Rock by cable car and gaze at the coastal panorama. Cross the Strait of Gibraltar to North Africa where French-influenced **Tangier** will delight you with its ancient kasbah, lively souk and aromatic cuisine. The final call is **La Coruña** in the Spanish province of Galicia. Stroll along the seafront promenade, discover the old town and visit the Roman built Tower of Hercules, the oldest working lighthouse in the world. Alternatively, take an excursion to the famous pilgrimage city of Santiago de Compostela with its outstanding medieval architecture. Your return to Dublin offers the opportunity to relax and reflect on the highlights of this wonderful cruise.

OCEAN COUNTESS CABIN INFORMATION

There are fourteen categories of accommodation on board Ocean Countess from standard cabins to suites that are generally categorised and priced according to size and deck position. Whichever grade you choose, your cabin steward will be pleased to serve you and ensure that you enjoy a comfortable stay. All cabins comprise en-suite facilities including a shower, washbasin and toilet plus personal safes, hairdryers, telephones with international dialling and flat screen TVs with satellite stations. The higher graded deluxe cabins and suites have baths with showers and a mini bar facility.



Standard Twin Inner (Category 1)

Category 1: Standard Twin Inner (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

Located on Admiral Deck, these cabins have two lower beds. The majority of these cabins can accommodate a third or fourth passenger in upper Pullman berths.

Category 2: Standard Twin Inner (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

These standard cabins with two lower beds are situated on Main Deck and most have upper Pullman berths for a third or fourth occupant. Cabins 4145 and 4147 are specially equipped for wheelchair passengers.



Standard Plus Twin Inner (Category 3)

Category 3: Standard Plus Twin Inner (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

All of these twin lower bed cabins can be found on Reception Deck, fourteen of which provide an upper Pullman berth for a third person.

Category 4: Superior Twin Inner (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

There are fourteen Superior Twin Inner cabins with lower beds on Upper Deck and ten conveniently located on Promenade Deck. Some can accommodate a third or fourth passenger in upper Pullman berths.

Category 5: Standard Single Inner (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

On Main Deck there are ten cabins particularly suited to the single traveller.



Standard Twin Ocean View (Category 6)

Category 6: Standard Twin Ocean View (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

Situated on Admiral Deck, these cabins have twin lower beds with ocean views through portholes. Some of these cabins can accommodate a third occupant in an upper Pullman berth. Cabin 3013 has a Queen Size bed.

Category 7: Standard Twin Ocean View (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

Comprising two lower beds, some with an upper Pullman berth, all have ocean views through portholes and are located on Main Deck.



Standard Plus Twin Ocean View (Category 8)

Category 8: Standard Plus Twin Ocean View (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

This grade of ocean view cabin with portholes can be found in the forward section on Reception Deck. Cabin 5003 has a Queen Size bed, all other cabins have two lower beds.



Superior Twin Ocean View (Category 9)

Category 9: Superior Twin Ocean View (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

These cabins are all situated on Reception Deck and comprise two lower beds and ocean views through windows.

Category 10: Standard Single Ocean View (AVERAGE SIZE 11 SQ M)

Ten cabins suited for sole occupancy with ocean views through portholes, have been selected on Admiral Deck and Main Deck.



De Luxe (Category DL)

Category DL: De Luxe (AVERAGE SIZE 14.5 SQ M)

There are four De Luxe cabins situated on Upper Deck with Queen Size beds. They have windows with views of the outside deck, bathrooms with bath and shower and mini bar facilities.



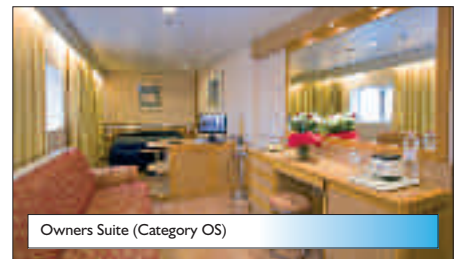
Junior Suite Double (Category JD)

Category JD: Junior Suite Double Bed (AVERAGE SIZE 22 SQ M)

These twelve Junior Suites on Upper Deck enjoy ocean views through windows. They comprise Queen Size beds and an integral sitting area, a bathroom with bath and shower and a mini bar.

Category JT: Junior Suite Twin Bed (AVERAGE SIZE 20.4 SQ M)

There are just eight Junior Suites with twin lower beds positioned on Promenade Deck. They provide an integral sitting area and ocean views through windows. They also feature baths with showers and a mini bar facility.



Owners Suite (Category OS)

Category OS: Owners Suite (AVERAGE SIZE 30 SQ M)

Spoil yourself with one of these two Owner's Suites that provide a spacious retreat in a prime position on Upper Deck. They offer a Queen Size bed, bathroom with bath and shower, mini bar and a comfortable sitting area with ocean view windows. These suites can accommodate a third person on a sofa bed.

Ocean View Cabin: Describes a cabin which has natural light from a porthole or a window.

Inner Cabin: Describes a cabin which has artificial light only.

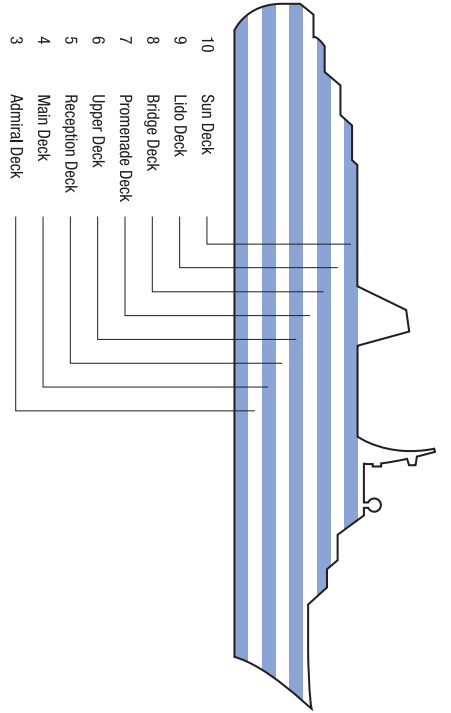
Lifts: There are lifts operating between Admiral Deck 3 and Promenade Deck 7.

OCEAN COUNTRESS DECK PLAN



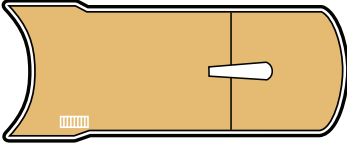

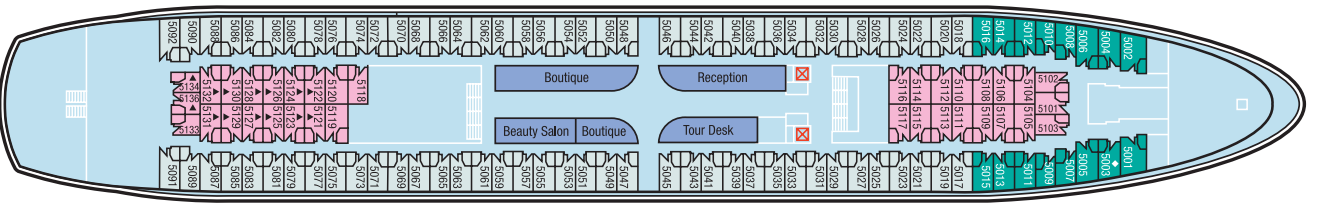

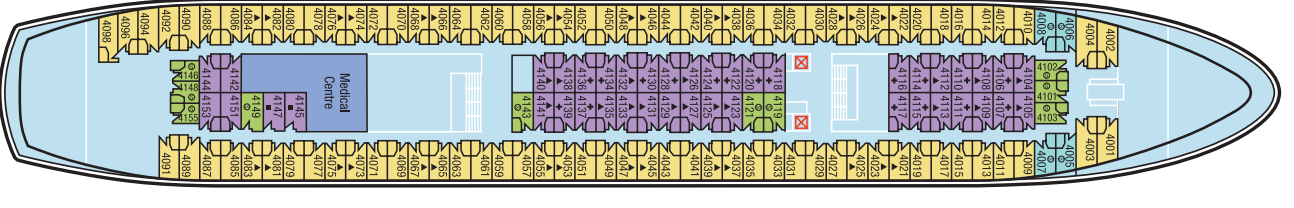

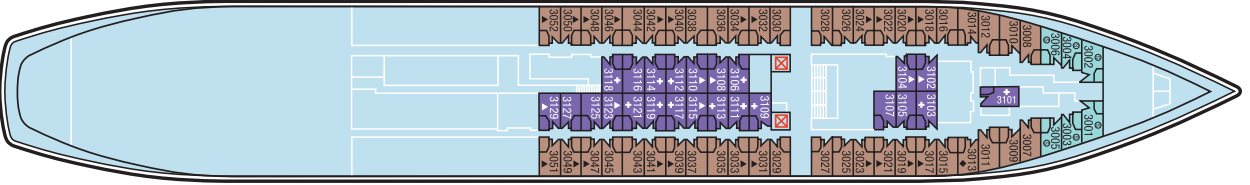

GENERAL INFORMATION

Please carefully read this General Information, which contains useful details that you need to know before you book your cruise holiday. Should there be some additional information that you require or you have questions about any aspect of your cruise, please do not hesitate to contact us. Fuller, more detailed information will be forwarded in our pre-sailing booklet around two months before you sail.

Baggage

There is no restriction on the amount of luggage that you may bring on board the cruises which depart from and return to the Republic of Ireland. As there are no separate Baggage Room facilities aboard our ships, it should be noted that all baggage must be stored within the cabin.

Brochure Information

The information contained in this brochure has been checked for accuracy and is correct at the time of printing in June 2010. Any such changes deemed to be significant or fundamental to your booking will be advised to you accordingly. It should also be noted that the destination photography and maps are generic to the locations depicted and may not be a specific representation of sights or images to be viewed.

Children and Teens

There are no dedicated recreational facilities for children aboard Ocean Countess, but nevertheless accompanied children and teenagers under the age of 18 at the date of sailing are of course welcome aboard and, when occupying a third or fourth berth in a cabin with two full fare paying passengers, travel at a beneficial rate as shown under the Fares box. Children and teens under the age of 18 at the date of sailing but occupying a twin cabin with just one accompanying adult are charged at the full adult fare.

Dress Code

During the day, attitudes are very relaxed and informality is the key. Casual clothing is quite sufficient during the days at sea and for time spent ashore. On certain shore excursions and at some religious sites, discretion should be used so as not to cause inadvertent offence with inappropriate clothing. There are generally two 'formal' or gala nights planned on each cruise when many gentlemen wear a dinner jacket, although a lounge suit is quite acceptable. The ladies on these occasions have a chance to dress up and often opt for evening or cocktail dresses. On evenings proposed as 'informal', a suit or smart jacket and trousers, with or without a tie, for the men is suggested and the ladies have further opportunities to look elegant in a cocktail dress, trouser suits and stylish co-ordinates. A 'casual' recommendation often covers evenings spent in port or when a special event such as a deck party is scheduled. In these cases, the choice of dress is left entirely to you.

Electrical Appliances

All cabins feature 220v current and have an electrical socket to allow small appliances such as electric shavers, electric rollers and curling tongs and to be used. It is advisable to bring a UK three pin to European round two pin universal adapter in order to access the electrical supply in the cabins.

Embarkation/Disembarkation Arrangements

The embarkation procedures normally commence 4 hours prior to the published sailing time. At final disembarkation, you should allow approximately 90-120 minutes from the scheduled arrival time before disembarkation. Full embarkation procedures and timings will be confirmed when tickets and cruise documentation is despatched usually 14 days prior to sail date.

Gratuities

According to international custom in the hospitality industry, tipping is accepted as recognition of good service. For your greater convenience we operate an automatic tipping system so instead of worrying how much and when to tip, an amount of €6.00 per person per night will be debited to your onboard account. You have the chance to adjust the amount to be charged to your account in order to reflect your level of satisfaction and this can be done by contacting the Reception Desk accordingly.

Health Requirements

At the time of printing there are currently no mandatory vaccinations for visiting any of the ports of call of the cruise featured in this brochure.

Holiday & Accommodation Information

In this brochure, we have endeavoured to provide as much essential information as space permits Ocean Countess. However, please bear in mind that from time to time, certain facilities, activities entertainments and shore excursions may be altered or withdrawn due to such reasons as adverse weather conditions, lack of demand, essential maintenance work or other reasons beyond our control.

Itinerary

It should be noted that the cruise itinerary published in this brochure is subject to amendment. Should major changes to the ports of call, other than timing adjustments or the order in which they are visited, become necessary we shall endeavour to notify you in advance.

Medical Declarations

In the interest of your own safety and wellbeing, you must be fit and healthy to take your cruise and all other travel arrangements that you book with us. Therefore, the Company must be advised at the time of booking of any pre-existing medical condition and of any change to a passenger's condition that occurs between booking and the sailing date. **Medical Declarations, on the Company's official form, will be required by all passengers** including those who a) are pregnant or b) have a mental or physical disability, including mobility limitations. The Declaration Forms are sent to passengers once bookings are confirmed. Cruise & Maritime Voyages reserves the right in its absolute discretion to refuse boarding to persons who in the opinion of the Company's Medical Consultant are unfit to undertake the cruise or who have failed to make full disclosure of their condition.

Upon arrival at the embarkation port, you will also be required to complete a Fitness to Travel Declaration. If you have suffered from any viral symptoms such as diarrhea, vomiting or flu-like symptoms within the 48 hours before sailing, you must immediately contact your GP and notify us providing details of the symptoms suffered. Based on the information you provide, if we reasonably feel that you are not fit to travel, we will not allow you to board.

The Company regrets that it cannot accept bookings from passengers who will be twenty-eight weeks pregnant or more by the end of their cruise. Please note that a failure to disclose a specified medical condition may additionally invalidate your travel insurance.

Medical Services

The services of our qualified medical staff are available to you on board in the event of 'mal de mer' or an emergency. It should be noted that the NHS does not cover treatment on the ship and there is a scale of charges for surgery visits and medical treatment. Such charges are usually claimable under your travel insurance policy, less any excess amounts.

Mobility /Special Needs

A cruise is quite unlike a land based holiday and the ships of our fleet are not ideally suited to prospective passengers in wheelchairs or those who have limited mobility. **It is therefore essential that you contact our office to discuss your requirements before you make a booking.**

It should be noted that the layout of the ship could considerably restrict such passengers' movement around the vessel and indeed preclude access to some of the ports of call, where gangway conditions are not conducive or passengers are conveyed ashore by tender. **Passengers with mobility limitations, or who have special needs, that are accepted for travel must be accompanied by at least one able-bodied companion who will be responsible for general care and assistance throughout the cruise.**

On Board Payments

All prices on board are quoted in Euro and Sterling and a cashless system is in operation for all your on board purchases. An account is opened for you at the start of your cruise and you sign a debit when purchasing goods and services on board. This is charged to your shipboard account and a final invoice is presented at the end of the cruise itemising all charges. This can be settled by Travellers' Cheques, Visa or MasterCard credit cards, and of course, cash. **It is not possible to use debit cards or personal cheques to settle on board accounts.** The Reception staff also offer a facility to purchase small amounts of foreign currency for use in most of the ports of call.

Passports

A passport is essential for this cruise and all Irish Citizens must hold a full ten year passport. Many countries require visitors to hold passports that have at least six months validity beyond the return date of the cruise. It is the responsibility of holders of non-Irish passports to check with the relevant consular authorities of the countries to be visited to ascertain if there are any specific restrictions or requirements for their planned itinerary. Any passenger arriving at the departure port without a passport, or with the incorrect documentation, will not be allowed to embark. Such circumstances are not covered by insurance and no refund claims will be entertained.

Restaurant & Table Reservations

Whilst breakfasts and lunches are generally served in the restaurant on an open seating basis, two sittings are operated for dinner in the evening. On days at sea, these sittings are normally timed at 17.45-18.00 and 20.15hrs and these

timings may vary during port days. You should state any preferences for a particular sitting and/or table size at the time of booking. Please note that requests for specific dining sittings and/or table sizes will be treated strictly on a 'first come, first served' basis and will be subject to availability. Whilst every effort will be made to accommodate preferences, no guarantee or confirmations can be given.

Safety & Security

For your complete security and peace of mind, there are stringent security measures in force at the embarkation port of Dublin. All cabin baggage will be electronically screened, hand baggage may be examined and you will be required to pass through an X-Ray arch prior to boarding the vessel. At embarkation you will be issued with a personalised ID card which is used for gangway control purposes and validates you as a bona-fide passenger.

Shore Excursions

An attractive programme of tours is offered at each of our ports of call. At the time of going to print, the exact content and pricing of the programme has not been finalised, but you will be sent full details and a booking form with your pre-sailing information around two months prior to sailing. We shall operate a pre-reservation service and, availability permitting; you will also be able to book on board with our Shore Excursion staff. Full details will be advised with the pre-sailing information.

Smoking

As a consideration to all passengers, there are designated smoking and non-smoking areas around the ship. Should international maritime legislation subsequently affect this policy, passengers will be informed accordingly. In any event, the restaurants will operate a non-smoking policy at all times.

Special Diets

Passengers with certain dietary requirements may be catered for and enquiries should be made at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance

It is a condition of booking that adequate travel insurance is held by all passengers and full details of the policy cover that you have in place, including the name of your insurer, policy number and most importantly the telephone number of the insurer's Emergency Assistance service must be provided.

Valuables

Each cabin has the facility of a personal safe for your valuables and important papers.

How to book

1. Once you have selected your cruising holiday contact your travel agent, visit us at www.cruiseandmaritime.com or call us on 1800 937 979. Our reservation lines are open Monday to Thursday 9-8pm, Friday 9-6pm & Saturday 9-5pm.
2. A member of our reservations team will check availability of your chosen cabin accommodation for you or your travel agent. A deposit of €150pp is payable or full payment within 56 days of sail date.
3. Once you have booked your holiday, should you subsequently cancel your booking, the standard cancellation charges will apply. We will forward a confirmation invoice to you, or your agent detailing the costs of your holiday.
4. Approximately 56 days prior to sail date, advance passenger information and the shore excursion programme will be forwarded to you.
5. Final balance payments must be received by us no later than 56 days prior to departure date.
6. All payments can be made by: Mastercard or Visa credit cards (2% charge), American Express (3% charge), Switch or Delta cards (no charge), or cheque.
7. Once full payment has been received, your final travel documents comprising ticket voucher, embarkation details and baggage labels will be sent approximately 14 days prior to departure.
